***Collect of the Day***

Presider: Let us pray,

**All: God of the prophets and apostles,  
your Son commissioned the twelve disciples  
to proclaim good news.  
Send us into your world to proclaim your kingdom,  
heal the sick, resist evil and bring the exile home;  
in the name of Christ who calls us all. Amen.**

***The Epistle: Roman 5:1-8***

Reader: The First Lesson is taken from Paul's Letter to the Romans,

Therefore, since we are justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, <sup>2</sup> through whom we have obtained access to this grace in which we stand; and we boast in our hope of sharing the glory of God. <sup>3</sup> And not only that, but we also boast in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance, <sup>4</sup> and endurance produces character, and character produces hope, <sup>5</sup> and hope does not disappoint us, because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit that has been given to us. <sup>6</sup> For while we were still weak, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly. <sup>7</sup> Indeed, rarely will anyone die for a righteous person—though perhaps for a good person someone might actually dare to die. <sup>8</sup> But God proves his love for us in that while we still were sinners Christ died for us.

Here endeth the Epistle.

***Gradual Psalm: 116:1 & 10-17 Dilexi, quoniam.***

<sup>1</sup> My delight is in the LORD, /  
**because he hath heard the voice of my prayer;**

<sup>10</sup> I trusted even when I spake; but I was sore troubled: /  
**I said in my haste, 'All men are liars.'**

<sup>11</sup> What reward shall I give unto the LORD /  
**For all the benefits that he hath done unto me?**

<sup>12</sup> I will take the cup of salvation, /  
**and call upon the Name of the LORD.**

<sup>13</sup> I will pay my vows unto the LORD /  
**in the presence of all his people.**

<sup>14</sup> Right dear in the sight of the LORD /  
**is the death of his saints.**

<sup>15</sup> Behold, O LORD, how that I am thy servant: /  
**I am thy servant and the son of thy handmaid;  
thou hast broken my bonds in sunder.**

<sup>16</sup> I will offer to thee the sacrifice of thanksgiving, /  
**and will call upon the Name of the LORD.**

<sup>17</sup> I will pay my vows unto the LORD /  
**in the presence of all his people;**

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Ghost,  
**As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end.**

## ***The Gospel: Matthew 9:35-10:8***

Presider: The Lord be with you,

**All: and with thy Spirit.**

Presider: The Holy Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to Matthew.

**All: Glory be to thee, O Lord.**

<sup>35</sup> Then Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and proclaiming the good news of the kingdom, and curing every disease and every sickness. <sup>36</sup> When he saw the crowds, he had compassion for them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd. <sup>37</sup> Then he said to his disciples, 'The harvest is plentiful, but the labourers are few; <sup>38</sup> therefore ask the Lord of the harvest to send out labourers into his harvest.'

Then Jesus summoned his twelve disciples and gave them authority over unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to cure every disease and every sickness. <sup>2</sup> These are the names of the twelve apostles: first, Simon, also known as Peter, and his brother Andrew; James son of Zebedee, and his brother John; <sup>3</sup> Philip and Bartholomew; Thomas and Matthew the tax-collector; James son of Alphaeus, and Thaddaeus; <sup>4</sup> Simon the Cananaean, and Judas Iscariot, the one who betrayed him. <sup>5</sup> These twelve Jesus sent out with the following instructions: 'Go nowhere among the Gentiles, and enter no town of the Samaritans, <sup>6</sup> but go rather to the lost sheep of the house of Israel. <sup>7</sup> As you go, proclaim the good news, "The kingdom of heaven has come near." <sup>8</sup> Cure the sick, raise the dead, cleanse the lepers, cast out demons. You received without payment; give without payment.
